With you, my love, I've found my soul.

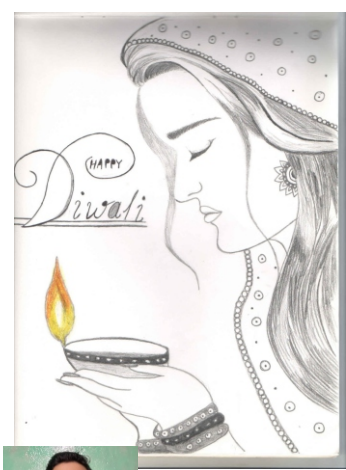
Diwali.

MULTIPLICATION TRICKS FOR 9

If you are having a hard time memorizing your multiplication facts, there are a few "tricks" that you can use. These tricks are based on the ways that numbers work together. The better you know about how numbers work, the easier it is to figure out your facts. (To multiply by 9 there are a few fun tricks)

1.One group less than 10

If you know your tens times tables then you can use them to figure out your 9's. For example if you have 9 of something, this is like having ten of them minus one of them. So 9×7 is like $(10 \times 7) - 7 = 63 - 7 = 56$.

2.Use your fingers

Number your fingers 1-10 by spreading out your hands in front of you and numbering them left to right. When multiplying by 9, fold down the finger that goes with the factor (not the 9). Now you have fingers still up that are to the right and left of the folded down finger - these represent the digits to your answer.

Let's try it. 9×6 . Fold down your 6th finger (this is your right thumb). To the left of your bent thumb is 5 fingers, and to the right is 4 fingers. The answer of 9×6 is 54!

3.Add to 9

All of the multiples of 9 up to 90 have a neat relationship. If you add the digits together you will always get 9 (9, 18, 27, 36, 45, 54, 63, 72, 81, 90). When multiplying by 9, the first digit of my answer is always one less than the number I am multiplying it by, then I just figure out what I need to add to get 9!

Example: $8 \times 9 = 72$ is the first number then since $7 + 2 = 9$ the answer is 72.

Understanding prepositions can be challenging, but here are some tips:

Prepositions of Time and Place: Differentiate between prepositions used for time (e.g., "at," "in," "on") and place (e.g., "under," "over," "between"). Understand their specific applications.

Phrasal Verbs: Many verbs are followed by specific prepositions (phrasal verbs). Learn these combinations to use them accurately in sentences.

Idiomatic Usage: Some prepositions have idiomatic uses, and their selection may not follow strict rules. Exposure to the language helps in mastering these nuances.

Prepositional Phrases: Recognize prepositional phrases to grasp how prepositions connect words in a sentence. Practice identifying them in texts.

Practice with Exercises: Regularly practice preposition exercises to reinforce your understanding. Many grammar books and online resources offer exercises for practice.

Read Widely: Reading exposes you to various preposition usages in different contexts. It helps internalize correct usage through exposure.

Remember, consistent practice and exposure are key to mastering prepositions.
